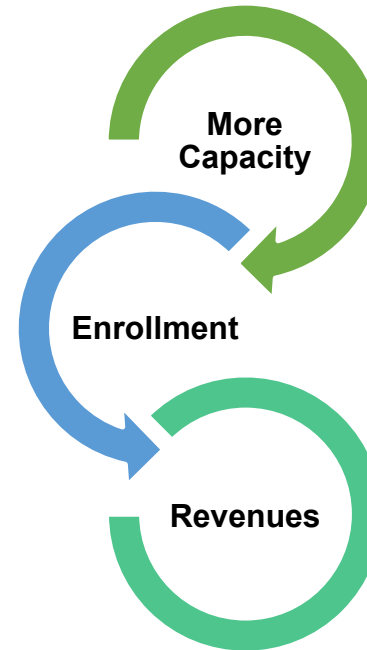

Background –

- Center for Senior Independence (CSI) established in 1994 by Henry Ford Health System (HFHS) (CMS pilot)
- 2012 – CSI established as 501C3 Joint Venture with Presbyterian Villages of Michigan & HFHS.
- October 1, 2014 – Board directive: Grow the company.

Assess the organization

- SWOT – (establish financial soundness)
- Feasibility Study
- Create a growth plan
- Obtain Board Approval

Examples of PACE Planning Ideas

- Reduce paper files to increase efficiency
- Review policies and procedures to reflect growth in census – are they sustainable and efficient?
